

Pursuant to Article 15 of the Public Enterprises Act ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Srpska" No. 75/04 and 78/11), Article 58, Item 10, and Article 61, Paragraph 1 of the Statute of A.D. OC "Jahorina" Pale, No. 218SA/24 from 07.05.2024, the Management of A.D. OC "Jahorina" Pale adopts the following:

REGULATION ON THE PROHIBITION OF DRONE USE AT THE SKI RESORTS OF A.D. OC "JAHORINA" PALE WITHOUT PRIOR CONSENT FROM A.D. OC "JAHORINA" PALE

Article 1.

Due to concerns about the property, safety, and privacy of employees and users of the services of A.D. OC "Jahorina" Pale (hereinafter: the Company), the use of unmanned aerial vehicles (hereinafter: drones) is prohibited at or above the Ski Resorts of A.D. "Jahorina" Pale – Ski Center "Jahorina" Pale and PJ Ski Center "Igrišta" Vlasenica (hereinafter: Ski Resorts). Drones may only be used in exceptional cases with prior written approval from the Company, which will define when, where, and under what conditions drones can be used at A.D. OC "Jahorina" Pale.

Article 2.

This ban includes drones used for filming for commercial or non-commercial purposes, as well as any use of drones by users of the Ski Resorts, third parties, media, or journalists operating above or within the boundaries of the Ski Resorts. This ban applies to all devices launched or operated from the Company's property, as well as all devices launched from private property outside the boundaries of the property managed by the Company.

Article 3.

The drone operator/owner (individual or legal entity) must submit a written request to the Company for the use of a drone on the property managed by A.D. OC "Jahorina" Pale, providing details about the drone owner: name, address, country, drone type, serial number, exact date and time of the planned filming, the location where filming will take place, and the purpose for which the filming is being done.

Article 4.

Upon submitting the request, the Company will assess whether there are valid reasons for performing aerial operations/filming with a drone and whether filming with a drone poses a risk to workers, users of the Ski Resorts, the Company's equipment and installations. The Company will inform the applicant of its decision regarding the approval or denial of drone filming.

Article 5.

The Company will not approve requests for filming or flying drones over people or

objects/installations of vertical transport, nor in violation of the regulations for drone operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Article 6.

The use of drones without the Company's approval will be reported to the competent authorities. Any violation of this regulation may result in the suspension/blocking of a ski pass if the drone owner/operator is a skier, initiation of liability for damages, including but not limited to compensation for disturbance, privacy violation, and physical injuries to individuals or property.

For any damage caused to the equipment of the drone operator/owner or third parties during drone filming (with or without the Company's approval), the drone operator/owner will bear full responsibility for material damage.

For any damage caused during filming (with or without the Company's approval) to the Company's property, third-party property, or injuries to third parties caused by drone use, the drone operator/owner will bear full responsibility.

Article 7.

(1) The operator/owner of the drone (who has received approval from the Company):

a) is responsible for the safe operation of the drone. The drone operator must comply with the requirements set forth by the regulations of Bosnia and Herzegovina, especially those related to safety, privacy, data protection, material responsibility, and environmental protection.

b) must visibly and appropriately mark the take-off and landing locations.

(2) The operator/owner of the drone is not allowed to operate the drone under the influence of alcohol or psychoactive substances, or in a psycho-physical condition that makes them incapable of controlling the drone.

Article 8.

The Company is obligated to place signs at the entrance and other visible locations at the Ski Resorts indicating the prohibition of drone use without special permission.

Article 9.

This Regulation shall enter into force on the date of its adoption and will be posted at the entrance and other visible locations at the Ski Resorts.
